Did You Know

When we first decided to become incorporated in the mid 1990's, we were still meeting in homes of members in Bel Air. We wanted a name that would include the large geographic area not served by a nearby UU church. So, we settled on Northern Chesapeake Unitarian Universalist Society. The paperwork, including our Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, was filed and accepted by the State of Maryland.

Not long afterward, the Quakers on Old Fallston Road in Fallston were kind enough to let us begin meeting twice a month in their Sunday School building. The Fallston area seemed like a good home for us. When we were notified of our inheritance from Helen Coon's estate, we opted to look for property in this area. Eventually we purchased the land and built the building that has been our home for the past eighteen years. Soon after we moved in, it was obvious that our legal name was unwieldy to use and not very appropriate anymore. Rather than spend a substantial amount of money to change our official name, we opted to just add “trading as Unitarian Universalists of Fallston.” Well, using it is at least a little shorter!
